- You will need to pay the Club's Subscription, Insurance and other External Provider (eg PlayHQ) fees by the dates recommended.
- You also need to abide by our Club's and the Great Southern Cricket Association's player conduct rules.
- You also agree to Cricket Australia and the South Australian Cricket Association policies on Safeguarding Children and young people.
- You also agree to abide by the Alexandrina Council's Code of Conduct regarding the use of the Goolwa Oval Recreation Precinct and the Clubrooms.
- Accept all umpire calls immediately without arguing or gesturing.
- Show gratitude to our volunteers for all the time and effort they spend working for the club

- promote positive behaviour and values
- eliminate or appropriately manage any incidences of harassment, discrimination and abuse that may occur within the Club
- clearly demonstrate that it will not accept inappropriate or unlawful behaviour
