26 / 4/ 1915

Goolwas batted first and compiled 165 runs. Mitchell with 70 odd was top scorer. Elliots went in to bat with a little over an hour to bat but were only successful in obtaining 119 runs for 4 wickets when time was declared. Bob Sladdin 48 and D.G Anderson 46 were top scorers for Elliots.

Goolwas have come out on top now and next Saturday Elliots and Middletons will play to decide 2nd position.

Victor Harbour Times report

3/4/1925

The final match of the G.S.C.A was played on the Pt Elliot oval on Saturday March 21 and completed on March 28th between Goolwa and Victor Harbour Clubs. The game proved to be very exciting. Victors batted on the 21st and were only able to compile 137 mainly owing to scores made by J Northey 70 and F Vickery 31, after having lost 3 wickets this pair took the score to 108, the end soon coming after Northey was disposed of. Goolwa were to lose 2 wickets for 12 at the close of the first days play.

On resuming on the 28th Goolwa lost their first wicket 22 and their 4th at 46 and things looked gloomy for them. However, Higgins and Kemp stayed together until the score was 76 when Kemp was caught and bowled by Reid. The play up to this time had been painfully slow 66 runs only being scored in 1¾ hours. Probert was the newcomer and soon livened things up and showed some of his old form of 10 or 15 years ago, and the rate of scoring greatly improved, and by 6 o'clock the total stood at 5 - 141, Goolwa thus winning the match with 5 wickets in hand. The main scorers for Goolwa were H.Higgins 48 not out, A.Probert 34 not out J.Rankine 19 and D.S Kemp 14. No other Victor Harbor players reached double figures than the two mentioned. The bowling honours for Victor went to Northey who secured 3 for 22 and at one stage of the game bowled 9 maidens in succession, during which overs he took the three wickets. L.V Reid got 2-29. Goolwa bowlers were as follows D.S Kemp got 2-14, J.Maguire 2-22, J.Byrnes 2-34, G.Ritchie 1-15 and M.Kearns 1 - 21.

At the conclusion of the match Mr Herbert E Welch President of the GSCA publicly congratulated the winners on having attained the premiership honours, and stated that he was pleased for the sake of cricket generally in the South to see Victor Harbour out of the premiership, not that he had anything against Victor Harbours but that the other clubs were beginning to think that Victor Harbour had a monopoly of the position, and it would now add extra keenness to these and other clubs to try and wrest the honours from Goolwa next season.

Mr N. L Wellington (Captain of Victor Harbour) and Mr M. Kearns (Captain of Goolwa) responded after which three hearty cheers were given for each of the premiers and the runner ups. Mr Welch then stated that he had another duty to perform which gave him great pleasure, and that was to make a presentation to Mr Walter J Dodd from the respective clubs of the Association for services rendered as secretary for the past three years. Unfortunately, this year the Port Elliot Club had found it impossible to carry on after the end of November, so that Mr Dodd's club interest then ceased, he being secretary of the club as well as the association, but he still carried out the duties of secretary to the Association in his own capable manner. He then presented Mr Dodd with a cheque for £6 donated from each club associated. Mr Dodd responded and thanked the clubs for this unlooked for, but appreciation of his services, which were always available for the games of both cricket and football, that he was still keenly interested in, although he was unable to take an active part in at present.
